● Key Points

- Carbon Management will be a critical aspect as Fossil PG will be a key element in the mix
- successful deployment of technology is essential with a need for appropriately targeted measures to encourage take-up in a risk adverse marketplace
- energy efficiency and improved use of energy remains an important issue; essential to restore confidence in CHP
