 - CO₂ most significant GHG
- **Desire for Sustainable Energy Future**
 - How to meet Kyoto targets and beyond
 - Security of Supply issues
 - Clean Use of Fossil Fuels in the Energy Mix
- **Future UK Energy Policy White Paper**
 - Potential of CO₂ Capture and Storage for Fossil Fuel Plant as part of a set of complementary measures for CO₂ Mitigation
 - Window of Opportunity for Enhanced Oil Recovery in North Sea

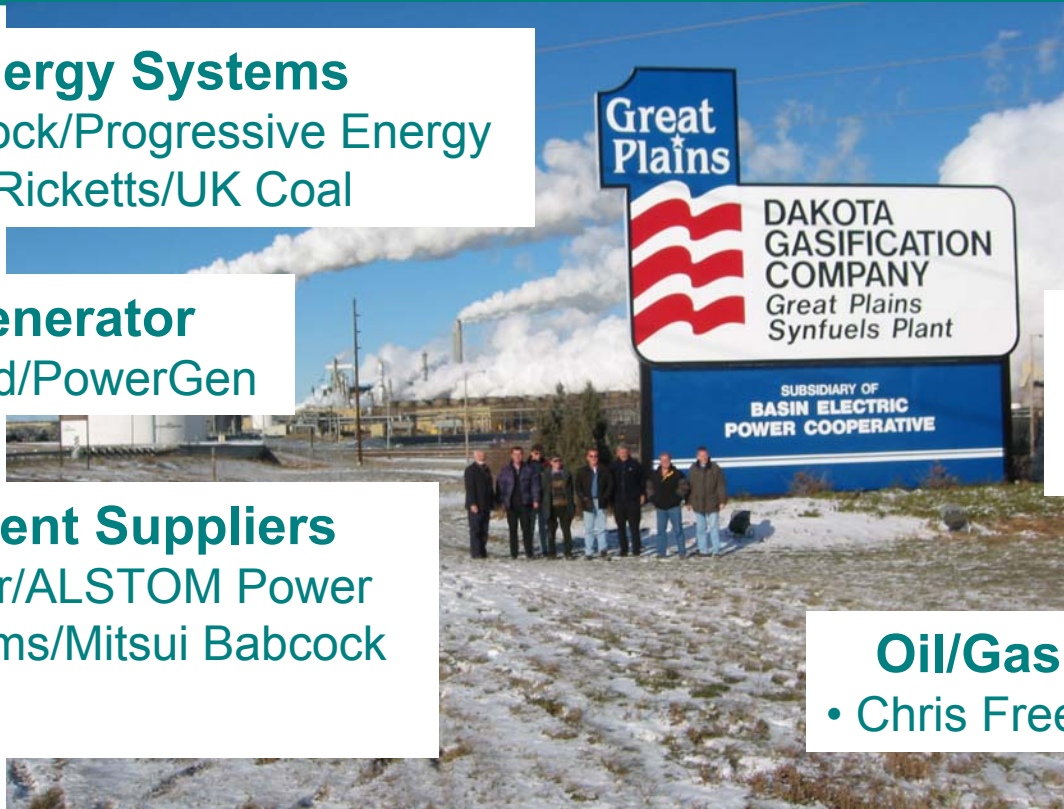

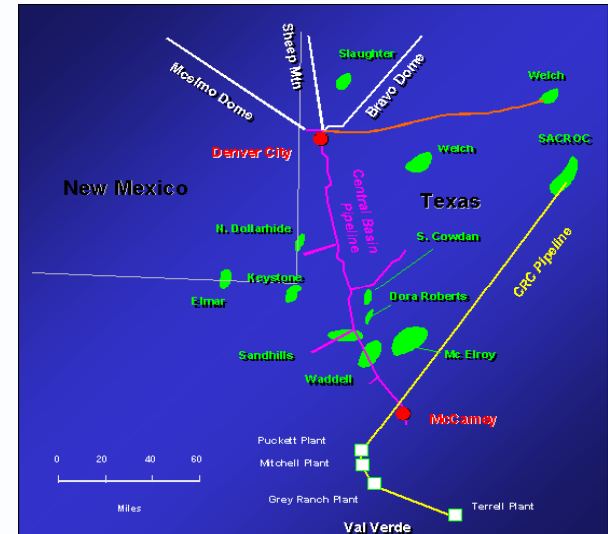
